SHARING BY PASTOR LAWRENCE

Beloved brethren, grace to you, and peace, from God our Father, the Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit.

It has been more than a month since the covid19 pandemic wreaked havoc around the world, starting from Wuhan. The death toll globally has now exceeded 120,000 and more than 1.9 million were infected with the virus.

Due to this deadly pandemic, economically, socially, psychologically and even spiritually many are in distress. Businesses collapse, jobs are lost and all forms of gathering are banned. Many of our daily routine, going to work and school, meeting people, even going for holiday trips are all disrupted.

In times like this, as God's people, what is our response?

First, acknowledge the Sovereignty of God. He allows it for His purposes and His glory. We may understand a little or not understand at all, it is fine. Just trust that God is love, righteous and just. Have faith in Him.

Psalms 135:6 "Whatever the Lord pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all deeps."

Romans 9:19-21 "You will say to me then, 'Why does he still find fault? For who can resist his will?' 20 But who are you, O man, to answer back to God? Will what is molded say to its molder, 'Why have you made me like this?' 21 Has the potter no right over the clay, to make out of the same lump one vessel for honorable use and another for dishonorable use?"

Second, read His Word, study and meditate on it. Joshua 1:8 "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success." (Read Psalm 1:2-3)

2 Timothy 3:16 "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work."

Third, pray. Philippians 4:6 "do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

Ephesians 6:18 "praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,"

Fourth, do good. Ephesians 2:10 "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

Micah 6:8 "He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?"

May this unprecedented time become a great opportunity for us to share God's Good News to a world that needs our message of hope.
